

# Artistic Digitizer Glam Bag

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Tired of smearing the inside of your purse with lipstick? Or, are you searching the far reaches of your bag for your favorite lip gloss? Then, this little bag is the project for you! Keep your lipsticks and lip glosses tidy and easy to find with this cute, glamorous bag. Approximate Size: 3.5" x 6"



**Skill:** Advanced beginner

**Time:** 1 hour

## Janome Supplies Required:

- Janome Artistic Digitizer- to create embroidery
- Janome Embroidery Machine
- Janome Sewing Machine
- Small square embroidery hoop
- Red tip needle
- ZigZag foot A
- Zipper foot E
- 1/4" Seam foot O
- Acufeed Flex 1/4" Seam foot

## Fabric/Notions Required:

- 8" x 8" fabric for embroidery
- 8" x 8" heavy weight fusible stabilizer (deco bond)
- 3" x 5" fabric for applique
- 4 1/2" x 6" outside fabric
- 4 1/2" x 6" - 2 pieces for lining backed with heavy weight fusible stabilizer (deco bond)
- 5" x 4" casing backed with Heavy weight fusible stabilizer (deco bond)
- All-purpose sewing thread
- Matching bobbin thread
- Embroidery thread
- Bobbin embroidery thread
- 3" Flex Frame

## Embroidery Directions:

1. Hoop the stabilized fabric in the small square hoop.
2. Open the embroidery design.
3. Stitch out desired applique technique.
4. Trim down to 4 1/2" x 6".

## Creating Casing for Flex Frame:

1. Fold the 5" x 4" in half so it measures 2 1/2" x 4".
2. Sew up the short ends using 1/4" seam.
3. Turn right sides out and press.

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## Assembly:

1. Lay the applique piece right side up.
2. Centering the casing piece matching raw edges along the short end.
3. Lay the lining piece on top.




4. Using the Acufeed Flex 1/4" seam foot, sew 1/4" seam sewing all the pieces together along the short end.
5. Open up the pieces and separate out just the casing piece.
6. Fold the casing piece toward the outside fabric with the fold of the casing next to the seam.
7. Top stitch the casing down thus forming the casing.



8. Place the top piece/lining right side up.
9. Lay the back piece/lining right side down on top of the top piece matching the seam
- a. Hint- flip the casing pieces so one is to each side of the seams.

10. Using the zipper foot and the needle all the way to the left, sew a foot widths all the way around the bag and lining, leaving an opening in the lining.



11. Turn right sides out.
12. Edge stitch the opening closed.
13. Push the lining to the inside.
14. Insert the flex frame.
